- 2. Show proof of acceptance or enrollment to a 2-year or 4-year College and University, trade school program, or proof of military enlistment.
- 3. Must have had minimum 3.0 GPA from the most previous semester/trimester. (Official transcript is required).
- 4. Must have exhibited livestock/poultry/rabbits **twice in the last three years**, specifically at the Gold Country Fair.
- 5. Applicants who have been awarded this scholarship once before are **not** eligible to apply again.
